FOR THE 8th BUDAPEST INTERNATIONAL ACRO CUP, FOLLOWING AGE RULES WILL APPLY:

ASPIRE:	min. 7 years old – max. 15 years old – rules on pages 12 -15.
PRE-YOUTH:	min. 9 years old – max. 16 years old – rules: FIG 11-16
YOUTH:	min. 10 years old – max. 18 years old – rules: FIG 12-18
JUNIOR:	min. 11 years old – max. 19 years old – rules: FIG 13-19
SENIOR:	min. 12 years old – rules: FIG Senior

MAXIMUM SIZE OF DELEGATIONS:

Each delegation may include:

- 1 Head of delegation
- Coaches: 1-5, depends on the number of gymnasts
- At least 1 judge is obligatory, no international Judges brevet needed. Delegations without judges must pay 350 EUR penalty.

COMPETITION FORMAT:

This competition will be organized following the FIG regulations, except for any deviation mentioned in this invitation document.

One gymnast can NOT participate in two units (pair/group) during the competition.

Qualifications:

- ASPIRE: 1 Combined Exercise
(the difficulty is calculated as in FIG – Pre-Youth) – 2’30” maximum duration
- PRE-YOUTH/YOUTH/JUNIOR/SENIOR: 1 balance and 1 dynamic exercise

Finals:

- ASPIRE – Combined Exercise
- PRE-YOUTH – Balance or Dynamic according to FIG rules PRE-YOUTH:

Women’s Pairs: Dynamic

Mixed Pairs: Balance

Men’s Pairs: Dynamic

Women’s Groups: Balance

Men’s Groups: Dynamic

- YOUTH, JUNIOR and SENIOR – Combined Exercise

Scores in all finals start from zero.

DEADLINES:

The number of teams that can enter the competition is limited by the LOC. The principle of “first come-first served” will be used, based on the provisional entries. Participation is only guaranteed after the definitive entry has been submitted and the prepayment has arrived in our accounts upon the deadline of the definitive entry.

Payment during the accreditation is not allowed!

All registrations have to be made through Acro Companion.

Provisional entry: 23rd August 2026 (no payment)

Definitive entry: 20th September 2026 (50% accommodation costs+ 100% entry fee)

Nominative entry: 1st November 2026 (2nd 50% accommodation costs + extra farewell party ticket and extra meal payment)

All clubs/teams should register via Acro Companion.

- **The entry fee is not refundable.**
- **The accommodations are only refundable if cancellations are made until 25th October 2026.**

ENTRY FEE:

50 EUR / gymnast for all age groups. **(The entry fee is not refundable.)**

- At least 1 judge per delegation is obligatory. Delegations without judges must pay a 350 EUR penalty.

OFFICIAL HOTELS, MEALS, TRANSPORTS:

Hotel Prices:

Single room : 167 Euro/ night/person

Double room : 125 Euro/night/person

Triple room: 119 Euro/night/person - **limited availability** - rooms will be allocated at “first come, first serve” basis. You will be notified if this type of room is no longer available.

The cost includes the meals!

The cost includes the meals for the delegations who booked their accommodation through the LOC.

- Breakfast will be served at the hotel. Lunch and dinner will be served at the competition venue.
- Every person with accreditation (gymnasts, coaches, judges, head of delegation) and booked their hotel through the LOC can participate in the farewell party without additional payment.
- NO Accreditation means NO Farewell party tickets.
- Meals are only provided on the official days of the competition (from Wednesday dinner- until Monday breakfast). In case of earlier arrival date, only breakfast will be included to the price of the hotel.
- If you haven't booked via LOC, meals (lunch/dinner) are available at € 15/meal/person. Please register your meal request on Acro Companion until 20th September (definitive registration), and payment until 1st November (nominative registration).
- Additional farewell party tickets are available for € 80 per person for limited time only! Tickets will be sold in order of request. Please register your ticket request on Acro Companion until 20th September (definitive registration), and payment until 1st November (nominative registration).
- Transfers from and to Budapest International Airport, Budapest railway stations to the official hotels as well as between the official hotels and the competition venue will be provided to the delegations who booked their accommodation through the Local Organizing Committee. The transport schedule will be communicated day by day. The schedule will be strictly followed by the drivers. PLEASE ALWAYS BE ON TIME!!!
- At the time of check-in, each delegation must pay a deposit of € 500 to the hotel reception. This deposit will be returned in full at the time of check-out but only if the delegation returns the allocated room(s) in its/their original and proper state (= at the time of check-in) and if there is no damage done by the delegation in the hotel.
- We can only accommodate the following food intolerances and special diets: vegetarian, lactose/gluten free. We cannot be held responsible for other allergies/intolerances, such as nuts. It is the responsibility of those with food allergies and intolerances to choose the right foods for their meals.

FINANCES:

The delegations are responsible for covering their travel expenses, accommodation, meals, and entry fees. It is the responsibility of the delegations to settle all costs by transfer by the deadline. Payment on-site is not possible! The deadline for payment of 100% of the entry fee, 50% of the accommodation package is the time of the definitive registration (20.09.2026.), and the other 50% of the accommodation, extra farewell party ticket, and extra meal payment at the time of the nominative registration (1.11.2026).

The entry fee is not refundable. The accommodations are only refundable if cancellations are made until 25th October 2026.

Visa:

If you need an official invitation to obtain a visa to travel to Hungary, please contact the LOC as soon as possible.

Make sure all possible transfer charges (sending and receiving) are paid to ensure the correct amount is deposited in our account. When making an international bank transfer you can usually choose between different options, depending on who should pay the fees. The participating federation is responsible for covering all bank fees in connection with the bank transfers.

TARIFF SHEETS, MUSIC

The **tariff sheets and musics** must be sent on the **ACROCOMPANION** software.

Deadline: 15th November 2026.

INSURANCE:

All delegations are responsible for having the necessary coverage against accidents and illness.

Proof of adequate insurance coverage and comps of passports should be submitted to Acro Companion.

OPENING AND MEDAL AWARD CEREMONIES:

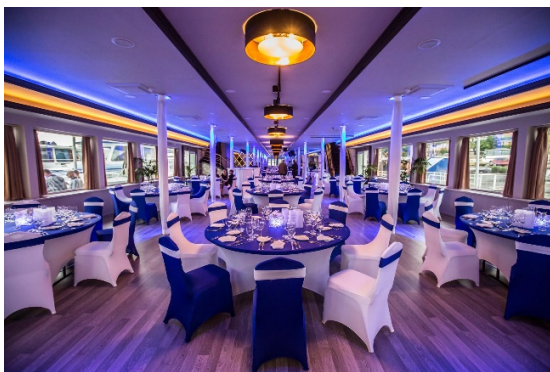
No gymnast will be requested to participate in the Opening Ceremony.

Only the first three places will be requested to participate in the Medal Award Ceremonies. They are requested to appear in a National or Team tracksuit.

MEDIA:

The organization committee records and streams the competition and has the right to put the recordings online. Entering the competition automatically grants BIAC and the Hungarian Gymnastics Federation the rights to use and publish all photographic material and image rights. During accreditation, GDPR declarations must be signed by the Heads of delegations.

FAREWELL PARTY:



The farewell dinner will be organized as a sight-seeing cruise on the Danube River. Every person with accreditation card (gymnasts, coaches, judges, head of delegation) and booked their hotel through the LOC can participate in the farewell party without additional payment.

Extra tickets will be available € 80 / person. Requests for extra tickets must be made at the very latest 20th September 2026 on Acro Companion, and should be paid by the nominative registration deadline.

Tickets are limited to the capacity of the cruise. Tickets will be sold in order of the applications.

ASPIRE RULES



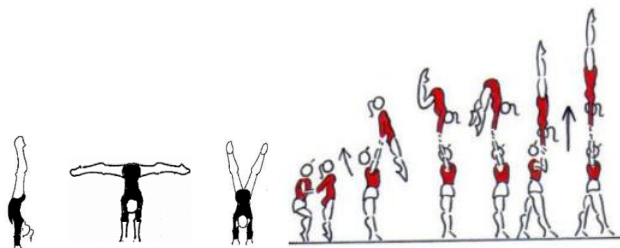
General rules:

- Each pair or group must present a combined exercise, which must be choreographed and performed to music.
- The exercise is composed of compulsory elements, selected from the World Age Group Rules, and optional elements, selected the FIG Tables of Difficulty.
- Music of all exercises has a maximum duration of 2'30". There is no minimum length. The first note of the music indicates the beginning of the time of the exercise. The first move made by one or more competitors from the start position is considered as the "start" of an exercise. The end of an exercise is the **static position** of partners, which must coincide with the end of the music.
- There is no height penalty. However, the rules for the logical relationship between partners in artistry are applied.
- Each pair/group must perform the elements as in the drawings.
- Each pair/group must also perform the required number of optional elements. Optional Elements can be the same as in the Compulsory Tables but not from the same row used in Compulsory and must be chosen out of the Tables of Difficulty. (to indicate that this is the optional element).
- Each element chosen from the COMPULSORY Difficulty Tables has a stated difficulty value, which is used to determine the Difficulty Value of the exercise.
- Optional elements are NOT used in calculating the Difficulty value of the exercise, although they must be performed to meet Special Requirements.
- The Difficulty value of the exercise is calculated according to the difficulty value of the performed elements up to a MAX of 0,5:

D-Value of Compulsory Elements
0.0
0.1
0.2
0.3
0.4
0.5

- A penalty of 1.0 is applied when:
 - For each missing requirement.
 - Performing more elements than the ones required.
 - A pair/group or individual element exceeds the stated maximum value.
 - A simple element exceeds the maximum number of rotations, twists or the maximum value of 5.
 - A forbidden element is performed. (see for forbidden elements FIG 11-16 rules)
This penalty is applied for each violation, even if the performed element is not declared on the tariff sheet.
- In the whole exercise, exactly 3 individual elements must be executed by each partner from any category (Balance or Dynamic). No salto is required.
- Individual elements selected from the FIG Tables of Difficulty must not exceed value 10.
- Tumbling elements (Flic flac, salto's, handspring...) must be preceded by motion (run-up, round off...) and land on one or two feet according to the character of the element. If an individual element is not declared, the element that follows is given no difficulty.
- Each pair or group may use simple entries, motions, links, catches and dismounts. They do not need to be declared on the tariff sheet.
These elements must:
 - Be selected from the FIG Tables Of Difficulty.
 - Not exceed value 5.
 - Not exceed 3/4 rotation or more than 360° twist.
- A penalty of 0.3 is applied for incorrect Tariff Sheet (element order, wrong element...). This penalty is applied only one time per exercise.
- All Special Requirements must be met within the declared elements on the Tariff sheet.
***Exception:** If a different element is performed to that declared for difficulty on the Tariff sheet by the coach, the gymnasts will not receive the difficulty value of this element. However, this element will count for Specific Requirements and there will always be a 0.3 penalty for wrong Tariff sheet.*
- Only 2 dismounts are allowed for difficulty.
- A maximum of 3 dismounts in the exercise are allowed.
- All the landings of all dynamic elements and dismounts with a value greater than 1 must be supported. If the landing is performed without support, a 0.5 penalty is applied for each occurrence.
***Exceptions:** Support is optional for dismounts from "cannon-ball" elements and the 5/4 gainer salto from wrap.*
- For developmental reasons, in both pair and group balance and dynamic elements, all handstands may be performed with legs in either a straddle or any allowed positions or with legs together to the ankle. There is no need to identify the specific leg position on the tariff sheet.

- Elements that move from low arm to high arm as indicated in the compulsory tables may be performed first to low arm then moving into high handstand as one motion, but the low position must be included in the motion.



Pairs exercise:

- There must be exactly two (2) Compulsory Balance Pair elements, each selected from a different row, I, II, III and IV of the Compulsory Element Table, i.e. one from Row I, one from Row II etc.
- There must be exactly one (1) Optional Balance Pair element selected from the FIG Tables of Difficulty.
- There must be exactly two (2) Compulsory Dynamic Elements, each selected from a different row, I, II, III and IV of the Compulsory Element Table, i.e. one from Row I, one from Row II etc.
- There must be exactly one (1) Optional Dynamic element selected from the FIG Tables of Difficulty.
- One of the Dynamic Element (Compulsory or Optional) must be a catch.

Pairs restrictions:

- The difficulty of the Optional Dynamic Elements must be a minimum of 1 value and a maximum of value 14.
- The difficulty of the optional balance element must be a minimum of value 1 and a maximum of value 9.

Groups exercise:

- There must be one (1) Compulsory Pyramid from a row of the Compulsory Element Table.
- There must be one (1) Optional pyramid selected from the FIG Tables of Difficulty, with a minimum difficulty value of 4 and a maximum difficulty value of 16 for the static hold of all partners. (Value of the base position + the value of the top).
- There must be exactly two (2) Compulsory Dynamic Elements, each selected from a different row, I, II, III and IV of the Compulsory Element Table, i.e. one from Row I, one from Row II etc.
- There must be exactly one (1) Optional Dynamic element selected from the FIG Tables of Difficulty.
- One of the Dynamic Element (Compulsory or Optional) must be a catch.

Groups restrictions:

- The difficulty of the Optional Dynamic Elements must be a minimum difficulty value of 1 and a maximum difficulty value of 14 for women and a maximum difficulty value of 10 for men.
- Women's group may perform max three (3) horizontal catches.
- Men's group may perform one (1) horizontal catch selected from the Compulsory Element Table.
- Men's group may perform one (1) horizontal catch selected from the FIG Tables of Difficulty.
